Fire Exploring gives dedicated young people, ages 16 – 21, valuable insight into the fire-fighting profession. This insight will allow the individual to decide whether or not he or she desires to pursue a greater role in the fire service. The Explorers meet at the various fire stations throughout the city every Tuesday. During the meetings firefighters teach various work skills that can be used to train for and enter the fire service.

Applications are accepted once a year in the fall followed by an interview. If accepted into the post, a mini-academy will be held for 6 – 8 Saturdays at the beginning of the year. Once the mini-academy is completed, new explorers will be given their ride-along patch and issued turnout gear. This grants explorers the privilege to ride-along, respond to emergencies, and train with the Costa Mesa Fire Department.
