

Happy City Survey Q & A

What is the Happy City Survey?

The Happy City Index is a progress report on the conditions for wellbeing at the City level.

How was the survey developed?

The survey is a combination of questions developed and published by Happy City in their Happiness Pulse Survey in addition to some questions pulled from a survey the City asked to over 40 businesses, non-profits, and educational institutions within the municipality. Happy City is a charity and community interest company, founded in Bristol, UK.

What does the survey ask?

There are two components to the survey. The first part will focus on individual happiness and wellbeing and the second part will examine how the individual interacts with and views the City itself.

What will the survey be used for?

The survey responses are being gathered to help the City enrich and focus our understanding of the community's social connectivity providing further insight that will help set goals for the City's Economic Development Plan.

How long does it take?

The survey should take 4-6 minutes and is completely anonymous.

Who may fill out the survey?

Anyone who lives and/or works within the City of Costa Mesa.

Where can I find the results?

Results will be available on the City website once we have received sufficient responses and conducted the appropriate analysis. We do not have a certain date.
