Honorable Mayor Monahan and City Council:

On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Mesa Del Mar Home Owners Association, I am writing to request a modification of City Council Policy 100-7 (as revised on 2/20/2001).

Our Board of Directors meets once a month and there are 11 Directors. We make it a policy to invite the attendance of any person who wishes to discuss any item of interest to the residents of Mesa Del Mar. Meeting in private homes has proved to be inconvenient. We usually meet at 7 PM so that attendance is maximized.

We would like to be able to use one of the first floor meetings rooms in the City Hall for our monthly meetings. The City Manager and Staff Members advise us that City Council Policy 100-7 currently precludes us from using any of those rooms. We request that upon appropriate proposed revision from the City Staff, that you modify Policy 100-7 to enable us to use one of the first floor meeting rooms.

Enclosed you will find a copy of the Article of Incorporation of the Mesa del Mar Home Owners Association dated 9/20/1986 and a copy of the most recent filing of our statement of Information (Domestic Nonprofit Corporation) with the Secretary of State for the State of California which is dated 6/12/2003.

We currently meet on the third Wednesday of each month and we would like to be able to meet in a first floor meeting room at that time. We are also aware the City Hall is open the fourth Wednesday of every month for the meeting of the Parks, Recreational Facilities and Parkways Commission. That evening might work for us but meeting on that evening would complicate our attendance at the meeting of the Parks Commission if desired. We would be willing to consider meeting on other nights of the month when access to the first floor at City Hall is possible.
