SUBJECT: CITIZEN INQUIRY: BMX BICYCLES AND THE SKATE PARK

At the October 4, 2004 City Council meeting, Mr. Adam Pope asked why BMX bicycles were not going to be allowed in the new Skate Park. Recreation staff has spoken with Mr. Pope several times on this issue.

At this time, no decision has been made on several operational issues of the Skate Park, including BMX bicycles. Staff continues to research this and other issues and is discussing appropriate operations of the Skate Park with the City Manager's Office, City Attorney's office, Risk Management and the skate park designer, Purkiss Rose.

These operational issues, along with their pro's and con's, will be presented to the City Council at a Study Session before a final determination is made.
