

Skateboard

Sec. 12-21. Skateboard park.

The following regulations shall apply to the riding of skateboards at any facility or park owned or operated by the City of Costa Mesa which has been designated a public skateboard park.

- a. No person shall ride a skateboard at any facility owned or operated by the City of Costa Mesa that is designed and maintained for the purpose of recreational skateboard use and that is not supervised on a regular basis, unless the person riding the skateboard is wearing a helmet, elbow pads and knee pads.
- b. There shall be posted at all facilities owned and operated by the City of Costa Mesa which are designed and maintained for the purpose of recreational skateboard use and which are not supervised on a regular basis, signs which provide reasonable notice that any person riding a skateboard in that facility must wear a helmet, elbow pads and knee pads. Any person failing to do so will be subject to citation pursuant to Costa Mesa Municipal Code section 1-33.
