

Nancy Clark is recognized nationwide as the pioneer in providing alternatives to incarceration. She has been offering alternative sentencing recommendations to Courts for over 28 years.



*Nancy K. Clark*

A sociology graduate of California State University at Fullerton with an emphasis in Criminal Justice, Ms. Clark was a Superior Court Investigator with the county of Orange Public Defender's Office for 16 years. During her tenure, she developed the office's Alternative Disposition Program serving juveniles and adults countywide.

Ms. Clark writes pre-sentence and pre-plea reports. Having made thousands of recommendations to the Court, her duties include the planning and implementation of any rehabilitation & treatment programs and referral to appropriate resources with the primary goal of reducing recidivism through rehabilitation. Ms. Clark has also assisted Private Defense Attorneys in developing client-specific sentencing since 1975.

In 1990, Ms. Clark founded THE RECOVERY CENTER, a residential program for alternatively sentenced substance abusers with locations in Anaheim and Costa Mesa accommodating up to 100 residents. Her Education Center offers a Non-Residential Relapse Prevention Program, Acupuncture, and Yoga.

Ms. Clark lectures at the Western State University School of Law Advanced Trial Practice Class and has guest lectured at the University of California at Irvine, California State Universities at Fullerton and Long Beach. She has also guest lectured at local high

schools and elementary schools. She is a member of the National Association of Sentencing Advocates and a consultant to the Board of Supervisor's Task Force on Alternatives to incarceration.



Ms. Clark is a past president of the National Council of Alcohol and Drug Dependence and continues to serve on the Board. She recently completed a three-year term on the State Bar's Criminal Law Advisory Commission. She has been on the Board of Directors of the Alliance for the Mentally Ill and Addiction. She has served on Boards

for the YMCA Counseling Center, Mental Health Association, and Volunteers in Parole. Ms. Clark is a recipient of the Excellence in Leadership Tomorrow and the Award for Woman of Achievement by the County of Orange.

Nancy Clark's Corporation is the exclusive Orange County provider of the Shoplifters' Alternative Course, a nationally recognized program aimed at reducing the recidivism rate of Shoplifters. She also holds the contract with Orange County Sheriff's Department to provide Aftercare, Outpatient treatment, and Sober Living to inmates who are part of The BEST Choice @ Theo Lacy program while in custody. Other services offered by Ms. Clark's organization include Pre-sentence Electronic Supervision and Drug and Alcohol Testing.




