
1. Bike and walking trail access through the lower park area to connect Placentia Avenue to the River Trail.
2. Lack of parking in the lower park area to accommodate people unable or unwilling to use the upper parking lot to gain access to Talbert Park and the proposed wetlands area.
3. Trail access between the upper bird street area and the new pedestrian/bike bridge over Placentia Avenue connecting the east and west sides of the park.

I would like to request that a review of the Fairview Park Master Plan be included for discussion in our next Parks and Recreation Committee meeting.
