

800 MHz CCCS REBANDING

Power of Attorney

The CITY OF COSTA MESA, County of Orange, Calif., authorizes the County of Orange through its Sheriff–Coroner or designee, specifically its Communications Division, (hereafter referred to as OCSD/Communications) to act on its behalf to negotiate with Sprint–Nextel the terms and conditions of 800 MHz Rebanding. This 800 MHz Rebanding is required by the Federal Communications Commission. It is the expectation that Sprint-Nextel will pay all 800 MHz Rebanding costs. The results of this negotiation shall be binding on us.

The CITY OF COSTA MESA also understands that we may use this opportunity to upgrade, modify, or expand customer-owned 800 MHz CCCS radio equipment. It is further understood that this shall be accomplished solely at our cost, and in a timeline that matches Sprint-Nextel's 800 MHz Rebanding schedule, as approved by Sprint-Nextel at the time of negotiation.

The CITY OF COSTA MESA further understands that the County of Orange, its Sheriff–Coroner and OCSD/Communications are not responsible for damages, liability, or failure to perform regarding the subject matter of this negotiation.

OCSD/Communications shall notify the CITY OF COSTA MESA prior to accepting any offers related to 800 MHz Rebanding that would directly or indirectly affect the CITY OF COSTA MESA.

Any decision which the CITY OF COSTA MESA is required to make pursuant to this negotiation shall be made within 10 days of a request for same from OCSD/Communications.

The undersigned possesses the legal capacity to make this authorization on behalf of the CITY OF COSTA MESA.
