1. Indicate why you wish to serve on this Committee/Board:

I would be honored to serve on this Committee because through this opportunity I can assist and support both the Council and Planning Commission by providing research and other information necessary in the decision making processes. Decision makers need up to date research on available county, state and federal funding in the areas of Development Block Grants and Redevelopment Agency Funds. It is equally important for the Council to have information on the needs within various communities and how the needs of one community can impact the needs and or expectations of another. I believe that I have the ability to conduct the necessary research and act as a liaison to varying communities to provide this information back to the Council and Planning Commission.

With greater community participation, the City will enhance its decision-making capabilities in the areas of redevelopment and residential rehabilitation and thus the community will be better served. In order to do that, it is incumbent that there be mechanisms to educate and inform the citizenry on what can and cannot be done; what choices there are and why they are made. Through access to various groups within the community, I can support the Council in that role. The City needs to have wide-based community support for the projects it undertakes; that support will come from an informed citizenry. The ability to promote ideas and garner an active citizen corps will improve the City. There is funding available through Development Block Grants but citizens need to understand where and how they can be used to gain support for such projects. We must improve the quality of life for all Costa Mesa citizens. I can help in both the research in to what is available as well as communicating that information to others. It is through the twin avenues of research and communication that greater community involvement can lead to improved problem solving and neighborhood improvement.

One critical area for the growth of the City, improvement of its infrastructure and existing housing as well as improvement of the quality of life, is to focus efforts on West Side redevelopment. In order to do that, it is important that we utilize available funds. If there is money available to the City we should not allow ourselves to lose such opportunities. There are available programs that should be investigated through Development Block Grants which include the construction of domestic violence centers, food banks and senior daycare facilities. All of these are necessities within our city. Existing housing can be upgraded as well as improvements made to public infrastructure. At a time when financial constraints are severe, we should search for every way that we can get help.

Finally, I am very concerned about the participation in our civic life; the number of vacancies on this Committee indicates that this is a problem that needs to be solved. I believe that I can help resurrect this committee as well as provide a positive impact to City life.
