

RESOLUTION NO. 98-85

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COSTA MESA, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE LANDSCAPE AND SIGN GUIDELINES FOR THE NEWPORT BOULEVARD SPECIFIC PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Costa Mesa adopted the Newport Boulevard Specific Plan in July, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Newport Boulevard Specific Plan includes several implementation programs, including development of landscape and sign design guidelines for the properties with frontage on Newport Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, two community workshops were held on April 23, 1998, to solicit input for drafting of the guidelines; and


WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on August 10, 1998, and on a 5-0 vote, recommended adoption of the guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City to adopt these guidelines for the specific plan area;







At the regular City Council meeting held on Monday, October 5, 1998, the above was considered and the following action was taken:

Resolution 98-85, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COSTA MESA, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE LANDSCAPE AND SIGN GUIDELINES FOR THE NEWPORT BOULEVARD SPECIFIC PLAN, directing staff to advertise for the reformation of the ad hoc Newport Boulevard Study Committee to investigate other issues regarding the Newport Boulevard recommendations and the specific plan, selecting the Tipu and the Bottle tree as the preferred trees, for the freeway side of Newport Boulevard, directing staff to conduct a survey of the business owners in the area to see if there would be 60 percent support for a Business Improvement District, postponing any decision on the street banners until the study committee is reformed, and directing staff to prohibit certain land uses in the specific plan area.
