Dear Mayor Mansoor:

We respectfully request that the city council approve our applications for film permits on December 7, 8 and 11. These tapings will be a part of our Christmas specials. At your convenience we invite you to join us at one or all of the tapings so you can observe their diminis impacts.

As a note, there have been previous outdoor tapings where there have been no complaints to our knowledge. Besides the crew, the taping involves one or two individuals who sing into a microphone. There is no amplified noise. The microphone only transfers the singing to the recording equipment. Field observations at previous tapings validated that the singing cannot be heard at the property line with our adjacent residential neighbors. The individuals singing are approximately 200 feet away from the property line. Additionally, there is no light or glare slippage unto the adjacent properties.


