

STREET CLOSURE STANDARD CONDITIONS FOR THE CATTLE DRIVE EVENT

The following are the street closure conditions placed on the Orange County Fairgrounds (applicant) to date. Transportation staff is continuing to meet with the applicant and other City Department staff to work out the details of the cattle drive event. Additional conditions will be placed on the applicant as the planning process proceeds.

1. The applicant shall enter into a special services contract with the Police Department for traffic control during the event. As directed by the Police Department, the applicant shall provide traffic controls at their sole cost and expense, and in accordance with the Work Area and Traffic Control Handbook (WATCH).
2. Applicant shall provide notification to all residents and businesses affected by the street closures of the date, time, and expected length of delays.
3. Applicant shall ensure adequate access to affected business and residential properties. Affected business and residents means those businesses and residents that are directly adjacent to the event route within the street closure area.
4. No equipment, vehicles, or other items may be stored on the public street or right-of-way at any time prior to or following the event.
5. The applicant shall notify the Orange County Transportation Authority of the street closures at least 7 days prior to the event.
6. The applicant shall confirm that no conflicting street construction, utility work, or work related to adjacent property development is planned on the day of the event.
