

**MEASURE M GROWTH MANAGEMENT PROGRAM  
GROWTH MANAGEMENT ELEMENT  
STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE REPORTING FORM**

The City/County of COSTA MESA hereby states that it has an adopted Growth Management Element in conformance with the criteria stated in the Orange County Division, League of California Cities Countywide Traffic Improvement and Growth Management Program: Countywide Growth Management Plan Component.

The Growth Management Element includes the following components:

- Traffic Level of Service (LOS) standards;
- Planning standards for fire, police, flood control, parks and open space, and other locally determined needs (developing communities only<sup>1</sup>);
- Development mitigation program that 1) complies with mandatory development impact fees, and 2) will not supplant development impact fees with and Measure M funds; and
- Development phasing and annual monitoring program;

In addition, this jurisdiction complies with the following:

- Participation in inter-jurisdictional planning forums;
- Adoption of a seven-year Capital Improvement Program (CIP);
- Balanced housing options and job opportunities addressed; and
- A Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Ordinance.

A copy of the Growth Management Element, including all of the elements listed above, is attached to this Statement of Compliance Reporting Form and submitted to the Orange County Transportation Authority.

<sup>1</sup> Developed communities already contain public facilities necessary to support general plan land use elements, but may require new or improved additional transportation facilities to implement their circulation elements and the regional system. Developing communities still need additional public facilities to bring their general plans into balance.
