Not all cities responded with impound fees after the third impound. From past research, it has been found that:

- a) Some cities cap fees at the third impound, meaning all subsequent impounds are the same price as the third.
- b) Some cities have an escalating fee schedule by percentage for each subsequent impound.
- c) Some cities, such as Costa Mesa under its last contract with the Orange County Humane Society, increase fees by flat increments (\$12.50) for each subsequent impound.
