The witness says they were standing next to a silver sedan. Officer Reitz (#527) sees a similar car leaving the parking lot, and stops the car. Rendon is the driver, and [REDACTED] the front passenger. Both are identified by the witness as tagging the fence. Both are arrested for vandalism, and Rendon is also arrested for DUI. On Wednesday, 01-31-07, at approximately 2212 hours Officer Casarez (#442) and I were working for the Costa Mesa Police Department (CMPD) Gang Unit in uniform, and in a marked patrol car. We assisted on a call of tagging in progress in the south parking lot of 2701 Harbor Boulevard.

While driving to the location, CMPD Communications advised that the witness, later identified as [REDACTED] saw a male and a female tagging the chain link fence where the old bowling alley used to be. Communications described the man as being approximately 6'1", 170 pounds, Hispanic, and wearing a blue sweater. Communications described the girl as being 18-19 years old, Hispanic, and wearing dark clothing. Communications also advised that both were next to a silver sedan.

Officer Reitz (#527) advised on the radio that he had a car with a similar description leaving the parking lot near the Acapulco restaurant. I know from experience that the Acapulco restaurant is in the northwest corner of the same parking lot. Officer Reitz stopped the car on Adams Avenue west of Mesa Verde Drive East. The car was a 2006 light green Ford Taurus, Illinois license plate [REDACTED].

Officer Casarez and I arrived at Officer Reitz's car stop, and approached the car. I spoke with the front passenger, later identified as [REDACTED] while Officer Casarez spoke with the driver, later identified as Carlos Rendon. I could immediately see that Rendon was wearing a dark colored sweater, and [REDACTED] had paint on her hands. Officer Casarez told me he could see several spray paint cans in the back seat of the car.

I asked [REDACTED] to step out of the car so I could talk to her. Part of the conversation was recorded on my digital audio recorder. [REDACTED] told me a friend named Alex had killed himself sometime in July of 2006, and today was his birthday. She explained that she had gone to his grave with several other friends and had been drinking alcohol. [REDACTED] told me she did not know Rendon's name, and had just met him. Later in the conversation, she told me she had met him several times, but continued to claim that she did not know his name. I asked [REDACTED] several times if there was any spray paint where they had just come from, and she kept telling me she did not know. [REDACTED] did admit to tagging a piece of cardboard, but said that a friend left with it. I asked her again if there should be any paint where they came from, and she told me, "My other friends were painting, so there should be." [REDACTED] told me there were two other friends in another car who tagged, but they left before the police showed up.

Officer Casarez spoke to Rendon, while I was talking to [REDACTED]. Officer Casarez later told me that Rendon admitted to tagging on a tarp where he just came from. Rendon told him he tagged "Johnson" on the tarp because he had been arrested by an Officer Johnson before.

Officer Parsons (#524) had contacted [REDACTED] while we were talking with Rendon and [REDACTED]. Officer Parsons drove [REDACTED] to the car stop, and he positively identified both Rendon and [REDACTED] as spray painting the tarp. [REDACTED] signed a citizen arrest form for Rendon and [REDACTED] for vandalism, and provided a written statement of what he saw. Officer Parsons also took photographs of the tagging, and I attached them to this report. See Officer Parsons' report for further details.

Officer Casarez searched the car and found more cans of spray paint in the trunk. He retained all the cans as evidence, and later booked them as evidence.

Officer Casarez arrested and handcuffed [REDACTED]. Officer Casarez seat-belted her into the patrol car, and transported her to the CMPD. Officers Stukkie (#300) and J. Brown (#539) responded to the scene, and later determined that Rendon was driving under the influence of alcohol. Officer Stukkie and J. Brown arrested Rendon and handcuffed him. They transported Rendon to the Costa Mesa Jail. See their reports for further details.

I spoke with [REDACTED] in the juvenile room, and recorded the conversation on my digital audio recorder. I read [REDACTED] her Miranda rights from my department issued Miranda card. [REDACTED] answered, "I understand, Yes, and I understand" to the first three waiver questions. [REDACTED] asked "I get an attorney?" I told her that she could get an attorney if she wanted, and it would be at no cost.

I asked [REDACTED] what happened and she repeated that they were celebrating in honor of their friend's birthday. [REDACTED] told me that she went with her friends to put up "RIP" for their friend. [REDACTED] claimed that she started to use the spray paint, but nothing came out. She told me Rendon told her to "bail." [REDACTED] continued to claim that other people spray painted the canvas, but she did not really see them. [REDACTED] told me there were four or five people and another car when the tagging happened. [REDACTED] could not tell me anymore about the other people. [REDACTED] claimed that the paint on her hands was from earlier in the day.

Officer Casarez and I spoke with Rendon in interview room #3, and I recorded the conversation on my digital audio recorder. I read Rendon his Miranda rights from my department issued Miranda card. Rendon answered, "Yeah, Yeah, Yep, and Yes" to the four waiver questions. Rendon initially denied tagging, but eventually admitted to tagging. He told me he tagged "UDIE" and "Johnson" on a tarp in a parking lot at Harbor and Adams. Rendon explained that he had an encounter with a Huntington Beach Police Officer named Johnson, and tagged a heart next to the name as a joke. Rendon admitted the spray paint cans were his, and he used a white or silver spray can. He told us [REDACTED] asked him for a can, and also tagged. He thought she used yellow spray paint, but was not sure.

Officers Stafford and Casarez arrived and assisted me with the stop. The driver, Carlos Rendon, showed signs of intoxication. I called the DUI team for further investigation. The passenger was identified as [REDACTED] also saw several cans of spray paint in the back seat of the vehicle.

On 01-31-07 at approximately 2212 hours, Sergeant Beckman #424 and I were working gang enforcement in a marked CMPD patrol vehicle. We assisted CMPD officer's at 2701 Harbor Boulevard on the report of a graffiti vandalism in progress. Officer Reitz #527 stopped a possible suspect vehicle on Adams Avenue just west of Mesa Verde Drive West. Officers Stafford #511 and Casarez #442 assisted at the location of the vehicle stop.

Sergeant Beckman and I drove to the south west side of 2701 Harbor Boulevard and saw fresh graffiti spray paint on the green chain link fence cover which covered the chain link fence that surrounds the south west portion of 2701 Harbor Boulevard. The paint was wet to the touch and I could smell the fresh paint. We saw that approximately 100 feet of the fence line had been vandalized with silver, white, and green spray paint. We could not read what most of the graffiti vandalism said, except for two areas which read, "Sketch". I took pictures of the vandalism that covered the fence line. Refer to the attached photographs for further details.

I located a placard attached to the fence which indicated the fence was the property of National Rent-A-Fence. I telephoned the company and spoke to an after hours call answering service and provided them with the CMPD case number. The answering service operator told me she could not provide me with any information on what it would cost to repair the fence. I provided the operator with my contact information and told her to have a representative of the business call me the following day with a cost to remove the graffiti from the fence line.

The subject who witnessed the incident, later identified as [REDACTED], came back to the location and spoke to me about what he witnessed. [REDACTED] said he was walking home from the grocery store when he saw a younger looking male and female spray painting the fence line. [REDACTED] pointed at the graffiti on the fence line and said he saw both the male and female spraying the graffiti along the fence line. [REDACTED] said the male looked directly at him as he walked by, shook the spray paint can, and began painting the fence line with graffiti. [REDACTED] said that a silver four door compact vehicle was parked directly next to the two subjects. [REDACTED] said he then telephoned CMPD to report the incident.

I asked [REDACTED] if he could identify the subjects if seen again and he said, "Yes." I asked [REDACTED] if he would conduct an in field identification, and he said he would. I read [REDACTED] the in field admonishment directly off my CMPD departmental issued admonishment card, which he sated that he understood. We drove [REDACTED] to the location of Officer Reitz' stop for the in field identification. I shined my vehicles spotlight on the two subjects which Officers Reitz, Stafford, and Casarez were detaining and [REDACTED] said, "That's them." I asked [REDACTED] if they were the two subjects whom he saw tagging the fence line and he said, "Yes."

I explained the citizen arrest procedure to [REDACTED] and asked him if he desired to make a citizens arrest on the two subjects for vandalism. [REDACTED] stated that he did, and he signed the citizens arrest form placing the two subjects, Carlos Randon and [REDACTED] under citizens
