RECOMMENDATION:

1. Adopt plans, specifications, and working details for the Roadway Rehabilitation of Gisler Avenue from Harbor Boulevard to 100 feet west of Nebraska Place, City Project No. 07-02.
2. Award a construction contract to R.J. Noble Company, 15505 East Lincoln Avenue, Orange, CA 92865, in the amount of \$1,585,525.60.
3. Authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute the Public Works Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Based on staff's observations and recommendations from the City's Pavement Management System, Gisler Avenue from Harbor Boulevard to 100 feet west of Nebraska Place is in need of pavement rehabilitation at this time.

In July 2005, staff was successful in procuring grant funding for the needed work through the Arterial Highway Rehabilitation Program (AHRP) administered by the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA). Grant funding for 50 percent of the cost of construction was secured for this work on Gisler Avenue.

The scope of work for this project, in general, consists of the total removal of asphalt concrete pavement; removal and reconstruction of damaged curb and gutter, sidewalks and driveways; traffic control, striping and pavement markings; and all other tasks necessary to perform and complete the work as shown on the plans and contract documents.

ANALYSIS:

The City Clerk received and opened seven (7) bids for this project on September 10, 2007. R.J. Noble Company was found to be the apparent low bidder with a bid proposal of \$1,585,525.60. The Engineer's estimate was \$2,512,503.00; and the average of the seven (7) bids received amounted to \$1,861,363.80. An analysis of the bids indicates that the apparent low bidder submitted a proposal that is 37 percent lower than the Engineer's estimate. The variance between the low bidder and the Engineer's estimate can be attributed to the current market price fluctuations that are occurring within the economy. The Bid Abstract is included as "Attachment 1."

The license and references of R.J. Noble Company were checked and staff has found them to be in good standing. R.J. Noble Company has successfully completed many projects in the City of Costa Mesa including most recently the 2005-2006 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Projects: Rehabilitation of Wallace Avenue, Buoy Street, Kenwood Place, and Congress Street and the Cassia and Valencia Rehabilitation Project.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED:

The alternative to this Council action would be to reject all the bids. If all the bids were rejected, the City would have to readvertise or cancel the project. Staff believes that readvertising the project will not result in lower bids.

FISCAL REVIEW:

Funding for the City's share of this project is available from Gas Tax funds. A Federal grant will reimburse the City for approximately 50 percent of the eligible items of work.

LEGAL REVIEW:

R.J. Noble Company will furnish the necessary bonds and insurance, which must be approved as to form by the City Attorney's office. After the award and subsequent execution of the contract, a "Notice to Proceed" will be issued.

CONCLUSION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt plans, specifications, and working details for the Roadway Rehabilitation of Gisler Avenue from Harbor Boulevard to 100 feet west of Nebraska Place, City Project No. 07-02; award the contract to R.J. Noble Company in the amount of \$1,585,525.60; and authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute the Public Works Agreement.
