I am writing you on behalf of everyone involved with Angels Charity.

Recently Angels Charity proposed an idea to the City of Costa Mesa about replacing the play equipment at TeWinkle Park with fully handicap accessible playground or a "Universally Accessible Play Environment".

Thankfully the Costa Mesa Community Foundation, the Mayor of Costa Mesa, Costa Mesa Public Services and The Costa Mesa City Council accepted Angels Charity idea.

As you are aware the City and Costa Mesa recently applied for a grant from the State of California for a sum of \$930,000. The City of Costa Mesa and Angels Charity are working together on this project and Angels Charity hopes to have the financial support of many residences, small business and large corporations from the City of Costa Mesa. Angels Charity is in the process of raising approximately \$300,000 to go towards the building of the park and surrounding equipment.


