RECOMMENDATION:

1. Adopt plans, specifications, and working details for the Roadway Rehabilitation of Sakioka Drive from Anton Boulevard to Sunflower Avenue, Federal Project No. STPL–5312 (060), City Project No. 07-11.
2. Approve Budget Adjustment No. 08-052 (Attachment 1) in the amount of \$452,732.00.
3. Award a construction contract to R.J. Noble Company, 15505 East Lincoln Avenue, Orange, CA 92865, in the amount of \$431,044.60.
4. Authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute the Public Works Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Based on staff's analyses and recommendations through the City's Pavement Management System, Sakioka Drive from Anton Boulevard to Sunflower Avenue is in need of pavement rehabilitation at this time.

In July 2005, staff was successful in procuring grant funding in the amount of \$390,076.00 for the rehabilitation of Sakioka Drive through the Arterial Highway Rehabilitation Program (AHRP) administered by the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) covering 50 % of the total overall cost.

The scope of work for this project, in general, consists of mill and asphalt concrete overlay on Sakioka Drive from Anton Boulevard to Sunflower Avenue, localized removal of damaged pavement, and total reconstruction with asphalt concrete pavement; removal and reconstruction of damaged curb, gutter, sidewalks, and driveways; installation of missing access ramps within the project limits; traffic control, striping, and pavement markings; and all other tasks necessary to perform and complete the work as required per the contract documents.

ANALYSIS:

The City Clerk received and opened eight (8) bids for this project on March 17, 2008. R.J. Noble Company was the apparent low bidder with a bid proposal of \$431,044.60. An analysis of the bids indicates that the apparent low bidder submitted a proposal that is 10 percent lower than the Engineer's estimate. The Bid Abstract is included as Attachment 2.

The license and references of R.J. Noble Company were checked and staff has found them to be in good standing. R.J. Noble Company has successfully completed many projects in the City of Costa Mesa including the recent rehabilitation of 17th Street between Santa Ana Avenue and Irvine Avenue, and the rehabilitation of Gisler Avenue between Harbor Boulevard and Nebraska Place.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED:

The alternative to this Council action would be to reject all the bids. If all the bids were rejected, the City would need to readvertise or cancel the project. Staff believes that readvertising the project will not result in lower bids.

FISCAL REVIEW:

The total construction cost for this project is \$431,044.60. The AHRP grant provisions reimburse the City for 50% of the construction costs. The City will front the funds initially, and be reimbursed progressively until project completion. The City's share of the project funding is available from Measure M Gas Tax Funds.

LEGAL REVIEW:

R.J. Noble Company has furnished the necessary bonds and insurance, which have been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office. After the award and subsequent execution of the contract, a "Notice to Proceed" will be issued.

CONCLUSION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt plans, specifications, and working details for the Roadway Rehabilitation of Sakioka Drive from Anton Boulevard to Sunflower Avenue, Federal Project No. STPL – 5312 (060), City Project No. 07-11; approve Budget Adjustment No. 08-052 in the amount of \$452,732.00; award the contract to R.J. Noble Company in the amount of \$431,044.60; and authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute the Public Works Agreement.
