Subsequent to the completion of the staff report for the City Council meeting of May 19, 2009, staff was contacted by Council Member Gary Monahan to ensure that the Council Policy related to fireworks includes the City Council policy direction that the cap on the number of stands was raised to 40 total stands. Council Policy 400-2 was modified to include this provision and item #7 of the Policy states "No more than 40 permits for fireworks sales stands shall be approved each year." The revised Council Policy is attached to the staff report for the May 19, 2009 City Council meeting.

Council Member Monahan also requested that the Agenda Title for this item be modified to allow for the discussion by the City Council of Council Policy 400-2 pertaining to the existing restrictions on the number of fireworks sales stands available to groups within the limit of 40 total stands.
