RESOLUTION NO. 09-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COSTA MESA, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING NEW FEES FOR JUNIOR AND SENIOR SINGLE SWIM, AND ESTABLISHING ANNUAL SWIM PASSES FOR ADULTS AND SENIORS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COSTA MESA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, In June 2009, the City Council of the City of Costa Mesa adopted a single swim rate of \$5 for the Aquatic Program, and directed staff to review all suggestions for increased aquatic facility use and revenue; and

WHEREAS, City staff worked with Aquatic Program users to establish an Annual Swim Pass of \$300 for adults and \$260 for seniors;

WHEREAS, the Aquatic Program users requested, and City staff recommends the single swim rates for juniors and seniors be reduced to \$3;

WHEREAS, the Costa Mesa Parks and Recreation Commission voted to support the reduced single swim rate to \$3 for juniors and seniors, and establishment of the Annual Swim Pass and rates of \$300 for adults and \$260 for seniors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Costa Mesa, California, does hereby adopt the reduced swim rate of \$3 for juniors and seniors, and an Annual Swim Pass of \$300 for adults and \$260 for seniors and authorize that this resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately.
