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## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Give second reading to Ordinance 10-11, read by title only, and waive further reading.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The construction and demolition debris tracking system will require contractors to use a City permitted hauler to haul waste from designated construction and demolition projects. By requiring use of a franchised waste hauler that meets the 50-percent diversion mandate, the City is complying with Senate Bill 1374, which requires municipalities to track construction and demolition waste as part of their AB 939 diversion compliance.

## **ANALYSIS:**

On October 5, 2010, City Council gave first reading to Ordinance 10-11 by a 4-0 vote for applicability of the new standards. Staff has no further information on this item.
