

RESOLUTION NO. 13-xx

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COSTA MESA, CALIFORNIA, CERTIFYING THE FINES AND PENALTIES FOR PUBLIC NUISANCE VIOLATIONS UNDER CHAPTER III OF TITLE 20 OF THE COSTA MESA MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Costa Mesa has adopted Section 20-12 of Chapter III of Title 20 of the Costa Mesa Municipal Code, which authorizes the issuance of civil citations that impose fines upon persons who violate Section 20-11 of the Municipal Code of the City of Costa Mesa; and

WHEREAS, Section 20-12 provides that fines and penalties for public nuisance violations shall be set by City Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, a separate fine schedule for public nuisance violations will assist the City in both recovering costs and providing urgency for the property owners or violators to abate nuisances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Costa Mesa, California, as follows:

1. The civil fines, penalties, and implementing provisions for violations of Section 20-11 of the Costa Mesa Municipal Code pursuant to Section 20-12, shall be those specified in Schedule 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein.
2. These fines and penalties are subject to the provisions of Title 20, Chapter III, Section 20-12, and shall remain in force until changed by a new resolution.
