
Traffic Notifications



WASTE MANAGEMENT

Waste Disposal will provide waste management and recycling for the event. All dumpsters will be located at the OC Fair & Event Center and will be located on the Festival Field. (north of the Staging/Equipment Zone)

Dumpsters/Containers:

- (1) 40-yard roll off dumpster (start line)
- (4) 40-yard roll-off dumpsters (Festival Field)
- 50 cardboard trash boxes set-up at the Finish Line Festival
- 50 cardboard trash boxes set-up around the Start Line at Fashion Island.



On September 19, 2012 Governor Brown signed into law SB-1186 which adds a state fee of \$1 on any applicant for a local business license or similar instrument or permit, or renewal thereof. The purpose is to increase disability access and compliance with construction-related accessibility requirements and to develop educational resources for businesses in order to facilitate compliance with federal and state disability laws, as specified.
Under federal and state law, compliance with disability access laws is a serious and significant responsibility that applies to all California building owners and tenants with buildings open to the public.
