Dear Committee members

I am a 36 year Costa Mesa resident, graduate of Kaiser, Ensign, and Newport Harbor, followed by a few years away studying at Berkeley. I am a residential Realtor and the focus of my business is the vibrant west side Freedom Homes in Canyon Park, where I have called home for 13 years. Before moving to Costa Mesa, I spent the first 9 years of my life in England, and travel back frequently. While living in London for a year in my 20s, I became fascinated with London's sense of heritage; not just its glamorous history, but also its more working class. Its historic docklands area on the Thames was once a thriving center of river commerce, but its wharf-side buildings fell into disrepair in the 20th Century. Rather than knocking them down and re-developing the areas, the city and its developers had the forethought to preserve this piece of the city's history and repurposed these buildings into loft conversions and spaces for new restaurants and businesses. I will never forget having dinner with some friends in a converted spice factory. You could still smell the spices from 100 years before. I recognize that my beloved Costa Mesa doesn't have hundreds of years of history, but what it does have, I hope we can help to identify, raise awareness, and preserve: from its industrial west side to its farming roots around town. I am a huge fan of Clayton Peterson's Boathouse Collective restaurant on the west side, where a former boat-building warehouse is now a thriving music, arts, and dining space. I believe our city has many more opportunities to re-use buildings, even humble concrete tilt-ups, as we have seen with the Lab and the Camp. I would be honored to serve on a committee dedicated to preserving Costa Mesa's history. Through my involvement, I would hope to help shed light on our city's history to residents of my generation (I'm in my 40s), as well as to the next generation of residents, who may not be aware of it.


