

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RECOMMENDATION:

Receive input from the property owners and direct staff to initiate the program for this neighborhood.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

On May 28, 2013, Planning Commission directed staff to notify the property owners of the next neighborhood proposed for the residential neighborhood enhancement program; with the exception of two residential condominiums projects (one at 726 West Wilson and the Fountain Way community) and the church at 740 West Wilson Street, the neighborhood is depicted below:



Staff sent two letters to all property owners within this neighborhood, notifying them of the proposed program and that input regarding this program could be submitted either at this Planning Commission meeting or directly to the Chief of Code Enforcement for submittal to Commission.
