Description: The proposed request is an amendment to Planning Application PA-07-54, an existing conditional use permit for a restaurant located at 1749 Newport Boulevard (The Hub) that serves alcoholic beverages after 11:00 p.m. within 200 feet of residentially-zoned properties. Any changes to the operational characteristics of the restaurant are subject to review and approval by the Planning Commission. The existing CUP limits the hours of operation to 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 midnight Friday and Saturday and 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday. The applicant is requesting modification of the conditions of approval to allow the restaurant/bar to open until 2:00 a.m. on a daily basis.

Environmental Determination: The project is categorically exempt under Section 15301 of the State CEQA (California Environmental Quality Act) Guidelines – Class 1 (existing facilities).

Additional Information: All interested parties may appear and present testimony in regard to this application. If you challenge this project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you, or someone else raised, at the public hearing or in written correspondence delivered to the City, at or prior to, the public hearing. Any written correspondence or other materials for distribution to the Planning Commission must be received by Planning Division staff prior to **3:00 pm** on the day of the hearing. No copies will be made after **3:00 PM**. If the public wishes to submit written comments to the Planning Commission **after 3:00 pm on the day of the hearing**, 10-copies will be needed for distribution to the Commissioners, City Attorney and Staff.
