Description: Planning Application PA-16-53 to allow the establishment of a restaurant (Crack Shack) in a former bank building. This request includes the following:

1. A conditional use permit to allow on-site consumption of alcoholic beverages after 11 pm within 200 feet of a residential zone. Proposed hours of operation are 8 am to midnight, Sunday through Thursday and 8 am to 12:30 am, Friday and Saturday;
2. A conditional use permit for free on-site valet parking during peak demand times to accommodate the increase in required parking; and
3. A minor conditional use permit to deviate from shared parking (75 spaces required; 51 spaces provided; 60 spaces proposed with valet).

Environmental Determination: The project is categorically exempt under Section 15301 of the State CEQA (California Environmental Quality Act) Guidelines – Class 1 (Existing Facilities).

Public comments in either oral or written form may be presented during the public hearing. If you challenge this action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you, or someone else raised, at or prior to the hearing.
