Description: Conditional Use Permits to allow a state licensed alcohol and drug addiction treatment facility on contiguous properties serving 24 residents within six units; and an appeal of the decision of the Economic and Development Services Director to deny a request for Reasonable Accommodation to allow this sober living facility to be located within 650 feet of another property that contains a group home, sober living home or state licensed drug and alcohol treatment facility.

Environmental Determination: The project has been found not to be categorically exempt under Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if this action were found to be a project, it would be exempt from CEQA under Section 15321 for Enforcement Actions by Regulatory Agencies.

Additional Information: All interested parties may appear and present testimony in regard to this application. If you challenge this project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you, or someone else raised, at the public hearing or in written correspondence delivered to the City, at or prior to, the public hearing. Any written correspondence or other materials for distribution to the Planning Commission must be received by Planning Division staff prior to **3:00 pm** on the day of the hearing. No copies will be made after **3:00 PM**. If the public wishes to submit written comments to the Planning Commission **after 3:00 pm on the day of the hearing**, 10 copies will be needed for distribution to the Commissioners, City Attorney and Staff.
