NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council will consider adoption of Urgency Ordinance No. 14-xx at the regular meeting on October 7, 2014 at 7 p.m.:

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COSTA MESA FOR A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF NEW HOOKAH PARLORS FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED ONE YEAR PENDING A STUDY OF ZONING REGULATIONS THAT ARE NEEDED TO ALLEVIATE A CURRENT AND ACTUAL THREAT TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY RELATING TO HOOKAH PARLORS

This Ordinance allows for a temporary moratorium on the establishment and operation of new hookah parlors for a period not to exceed one year pending a study of Zoning regulations that are needed to alleviate a current and actual threat to the public health and safety relating to hookah parlors.
