



NOTICE OF POSTPONEMENT

Planning Commission Hearing on the Final Environmental Impact Report for the Electronic Message Center Sign

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Fountain Valley had scheduled a Planning Commission Hearing on February 11, 2015 to consider certification of the Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act for the Electronic Message Center Sign Project. **The Planning Commission hearing for this project has been postponed to a future date. When a new hearing date is scheduled, the City will publish the hearing notice pursuant to its standard noticing procedures.** The hearing, when it is scheduled, will be located at the City of Fountain Valley Council Chambers, located at 10200 Slater Avenue, Fountain Valley, CA 92708, at 6:00 PM.

The project proposes the construction and operation of a new Electronic Message Center (EMC) sign to display commercial advertisements to motorists traveling in both northbound and southbound directions on the adjacent Interstate 405 freeway. The project site is located at 10955 Ellis Avenue on an approximately 2.75 acre parcel owned by the City of Fountain Valley and shared by the City's Reservoir No. 1. The proposed project includes a Code Amendment to the Fountain Valley Municipal Code to allow EMC signs on city owned property and a lease agreement on City property for an EMC sign.
