Beginning in the summer of 2014, Orange Coast College shared the general framework for the College's modernization and Vision 2020 Strategic Facilities Master Plan in three public meetings designed to create a dialogue between OCC and our community.

Thanks to the participation of our community, civic and business partners, we were able to take the input we received and use it to shape the final plan we have before us.

We will be sharing the updated OCC facilities master plan, an update on the College's California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and the final reports on the requisitioned studies on Monday, April 27 in OCC's Student Center Classroom at 6 p.m. Free parking will be provided in lots A and B, with access from Fairview Road at Arlington Drive and Pirate Way.

The studies to be reviewed include:

- Traffic impact
- OC Fair parking structure/Fairview bridge
- Student Housing
- College Village Center
- Historical Structures

We will also be providing overviews of our shovel-ready projects that include:

- Planetarium
- Recycling Center
