Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Costa Mesa will conduct a public hearing on **Tuesday, July 12, 2016, at 7:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, in the City Council Chamber, 77 Fair Drive, Costa Mesa, California, to select a map to include on the November 8, 2016 ballot, asking voters to decide whether to approve voting district elections as defined by the selected map. Public Comments: Public comments in either oral or written form may be presented during the public hearing. Any written communications, photos, or other material for copying and distribution to the City Council that is 10 pages or less, must be submitted to the City Clerk **NO LATER THAN 3:00 P.M.** on the day of the hearing, **July 12, 2016** and can also be emailed to cityclerk@costamesaca.gov. Please note that records submitted by the public will not be redacted in any way and will be posted online as submitted, including any personal contact information. If the public wishes to submit written communication, photos, or other material for distribution to the City Council at the meeting AFTER 3:00 p.m., 10 copies will need to be provided for distribution. Please note that NO copies of written communication will be made AFTER 3:00 p.m. Any materials to be displayed on the overhead projector at the Council Meeting must be submitted to the City Clerk **NO LATER THAN 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THE MEETING.** If you should need further assistance, please contact the City Clerk's Office at (714) 754-5225. The City Council agenda and related documents may also be viewed on the City's website at <http://costamesaca.gov>, 72 hours prior to the public hearing date.

IF THE AFOREMENTIONED ACTION IS CHALLENGED IN COURT, the challenge may be limited to only those issues raised at the public hearing described in the notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing.
