Costa Mesa Cultural Arts Committee

The City of Costa Mesa Cultural Arts Committee is an eleven member appointed volunteer group that works with City Council to support cultural arts programs and to bring art awareness to the residents of Costa Mesa, the City of the Arts. This committee works to establish ongoing programs, community events and useful information that helps residents access the arts in many different venues, and through multiple sources. They are dedicated to incorporating art into public spaces and are especially interested in incorporating the work of local artists. The Utility Box Art Program is an opportunity for local artist to showcase their talents, while promoting vibrant and memorable public art throughout the City of the Arts.

How the Sponsorship Works

- Sponsor submits 1 to 5 high resolution (300 dpi) art designs files with the dimensions of 40 inches wide by 20 inches high.
- If approved, the production of the vinyl wrap, including installation, will take 4 to 8 weeks.
- A box location is selected and approved by City staff. Almost all intersections with traffic signals will have a utility box nearby.
- Sponsors will be recognized for their support of public art through the Committee's social and print media for the Utility Box Art Beautification Program.
- Proceeds from this program are utilized for the Cultural Arts Committee's Grant Program. For additional information visit www.costamesaca.gov/CACGrantProgram

Sponsorship Cost and Terms

- The cost to sponsor a box **for a period of one year** will vary depending on the size of the utility box. Total cost will be between \$1,500 to \$2,000.
- Branding on the box cannot exceed 20% of printable space and must blend into the artwork. The intent of the box is not to create a business billboard but a tastefully appealing piece of art that meets standards set by the Committee. No political, religious, or discriminatory subject matter will be considered.
- Regular maintenance such as cleaning or removal of graffiti will be the responsibility of the City of Costa Mesa.
- Damage, such as severe scratching or ripping, will be billed at \$20/square feet. (From our experience with the first 12 completed boxes, none have suffered damage larger than 8 sq. inches)
- The artistic wrap will have an anti-graffiti laminate coating that protects against graffiti and strong sunlight.
