Reason for Euthanasia(s) Listed Above: (N/A if none)

1. Skunk with broken leg from a rattrap, which was still on the skunk.
2. Raccoon with broken leg and de-gloved tail.
3. Kitten with upper respiratory was lateral and gums were pale.
4. Opossum was staggering and falling over; appeared disoriented.

Other Noteworthy Information: (N/A if none)

1. Responded to a sick crow call. The crow subsequently died and was submitted to OC Vector Control in Garden Grove for West Nile virus testing, as normally requested on dead birds.
2. Two dog impounds were returned to their owners.

Progress on any Short/Long Term Projects: (N/A if none)

1. Dr. Botros made an offer on a property at 642 Baker St. for use as a satellite shelter facility for Costa Mesa animals. The offer was accepted by the owner with a 35 day escrow period. City Mgr Hatch, Capt. Manley, and Lt. Bakkila toured the property on 7/21/17.
2. Lt. Bakkila coordinated with the Dep't of Fish & Wildlife to present coyote hazing training to City staff from the PD and Parks Dept on Wed, 7/26. This is consistent with the utilization of increased education and educational campaigns as outlined in the City's Coyote Management Plan.
