Lions Park Projects

The purpose of the Lions Park projects is to improve library services, and create quality programming and event user space necessary to meet the needs of the community. The projects will repurpose both the Donald Dungan Library to the adjacent Neighborhood Community Center building and move the NCC to the current library space. Features will include: a new two-story 20,000-square-foot library building and a renovated Neighborhood Community Center. The project will also add one acre of programmed park open space that will be used as an event lawn and provide residents with a variety of fun, family and educational events.

PROJECT UPDATES



On July 18, 2017 the City Council awarded a construction contract to Tovey/Shultz Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$28,739,822.00. The Notice to Proceed with Construction was issued on August 21, 2017.

Tovey/Shultz has completed the hazardous materials abatement and demolition of the Neighborhood Community Center. Site work for the new Library has begun with grading for the new footprint and preparation for underground utilities underway.

Project Fun Facts:

The concrete material removed from the Neighborhood Community Center is being crushed by heavy machinery to be reused in the foundation of the new Dungan Library






