NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Costa Mesa City Council at the regular meeting on **Tuesday, May 15, 2018 at 7:00 P.M.**, or soon thereafter as the matter shall be heard, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 77 Fair Dr., regarding the application of grant funds for the Traditional Capital Grant for Vehicles and Related Equipment for the Costa Mesa Senior Center.

Description: The City of Costa Mesa Senior Center is requesting that the City Council approve the resolution for the submittal of a grant application to the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) for the acquisition of a new vehicle for the existing Senior Mobility Program (SMP) and authorize the Parks & Community Services Director to act as the City's representative. Currently, the program operates with one shuttle, which is a retired vehicle from OCTA donated in 2015. The acquisition of the new vehicle would allow the City to continue to operate the program without concern about the life of the vehicle.

Public Comments: Public comments in either oral or written form may be presented during the public hearing. Any written communications, photos, or other material for copying and distribution to the City Council that is 10 pages or less, must be submitted to the City Clerk **NO LATER THAN 3:00 P.M.** on the day of the hearing, **May 15, 2018**. Materials can be e-mailed to cityclerk@costamesaca.gov. Please note that records submitted by the public will not be redacted in any way and will be posted online as submitted, including any personal contact information. If the public wishes to submit written communication, photos, or other material for distribution to the City Council at the meeting **AFTER 3:00 p.m.**, 10 copies will need to be provided for distribution. Please note that **NO** copies of written communication will be made **AFTER 3:00 p.m.** All materials, pictures, PowerPoints, and videos submitted for display at a public meeting must be previously reviewed by staff to verify appropriateness for general audiences. Kindly submit to the City Clerk **AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE, BUT NO LATER THAN 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THE MEETING**.
