NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT GP-18-01 TO AMEND THE CIRCULATION ELEMENT

The City Council will hold a public hearing to consider General Plan Amendment GP-18-01 to amend the Circulation Element of the 2015-2035 General Plan as follows:

1. Approve the addendum to Environmental Impact Report (EIR) No. 1053 (adopted for the 2015-2035 General Plan) related to the proposed Active Transportation Plan and revisions to the Circulation Element;
2. Approve the General Plan Amendment GP-18-01 to revise the Circulation Element related to City's Bicycle Master Plan, roadway typical cross sections, and policy recommendations by adoption of resolution; and
3. Approve the Draft Active Transportation Plan (ATP) as recommended by the City's Planning Commission and Bikeway and Walkability Committee by adoption of resolution.

On May 14, 2018, the Planning Commission recommended to the City Council on the adoption of the Draft Active Transportation Plan as recommended by the City's Bikeway and Walkability Committee including removal of the Tanager Bike Trail, which is no longer part of the proposed ATP.

Environmental Determination: On June 21, 2016, the City Council certified Final Environmental Impact Report No. 1068 (State Clearinghouse # 2015111053), adopted findings pursuant to CEQA, adopted a Statement of Overriding Considerations for air quality and greenhouse gas emissions impacts (both direct and cumulative), and adopted a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program for the adoption of the 2015-2035 General Plan. An addendum to EIR No. 1068 was prepared to describe the proposed amendment to the General Plan and the minor revisions to the previously-approved EIR. The Addendum establishes that the General Plan Amendment would not result in significant impacts to the environment pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162. No further environmental review is required.
