<u>Housing</u>	0	No linkages to housing were performed by Outreach this week.
<u>Temporary Housing</u>	3	Outreach was informed that 3 resident clients were independently housed on a temporary basis.
<u>Emergency Housing</u>	1	Outreach was informed that resident client was housed on an emergency basis through an independent source.
<u>Housing Assessments</u>	1	Outreach assessed 1 resident client for their eligibility for government subsidized housing benefits.
<u>Reconnection</u>	0	No reconnections performed this week.

<u>Collaborative Case Management</u>	21	Outreach was informed by housing partner that resident client has been matched for housing. Outreach will contact resident client and follow up with housing partner.
<u>Documentation</u>	5	Outreach assisted 2 resident clients in applying for their identification cards.
<u>Housing/Recovery Assistance</u>	12	Outreach provided resident clients with local and affordable housing listings.
<u>Job Connection</u>	1	Outreach linked resident client to a local non-profit job placement agency.
<u>Legal Services</u>	0	There were no legal services given this week.
<u>Medical</u>	6	Outreach linked resident client to medical services at local hospital. Client was admitted and provided treatment for ongoing chronic illness.
<u>Mental Health</u>	10	Outreach and OC Mental met with resident client and linked her to mental health county services.
<u>Other</u>	5	Outreach provided resident client with a food box and clothes.
<u>Rental Resources</u>	3	Outreach contacted housing partner to check on resident client's status for rental assistance resources.
<u>Social Services</u>	3	Outreach met resident client at Social Services County Office and assisted in applying for public assistance resources.
<u>Substance Abuse</u>	2	Outreach and resident client worked together to contact local drug treatment facility to check client's eligibility for services.
<u>Transportation</u>	8	Outreach provided 5 bus passes and ordered 1 cab ride to support resident clients' transportation needs.
