Clients Assisted & Contacted

Individuals Assisted	47	43 Resident clients, 3 Non-Resident clients assisted, and 1 New Clients.
Contacts	33	Outreach in collaboration with community partners contacted 33 clients this week.
Linkage	# of Linkages	Linkage Highlights
<u>Housing</u>	3	Outreach in collaboration with local housing partner assisted in housing 3 resident clients.
<u>Temporary Housing</u>	2	Outreach temporarily housed one resident and one non-resident client on a temporary basis at a local shelter.
<u>Emergency Housing</u>	1	Outreach was informed that resident client has been staying at motel on an emergency basis.
<u>Housing Assessments</u>	2	Outreach administered housing assessments to 2 clients. These assessments determine client's eligibility for government subsidized housing resources.

<u>Reconnection</u>	0	Outreach did not perform any reconnections this week.
<u>Collaborative Case Management</u>	16	Outreach in collaboration with local non-profit linked resident client to cleaning crew services. This helps client keep their apartment clean and ready for inspection. Cleaning crew was provided by local non-profit.
<u>Documentation</u>	8	Outreach met with resident client and updated housing documentation and scheduled for a follow up appointment.
<u>Housing/Recovery Assistance</u>	6	Outreach provided resident clients with housing listings for affordable rooms and apartments in their area.
<u>Job Connection</u>	2	Outreach was informed that resident client has been recently laid off from their job. Outreach linked client to employment resources and provided job listings.
<u>Legal Services</u>	1	Outreach assisted resident client in filling out and petitioning for legal services to assist with reducing client's criminal charges.
<u>Medical</u>	3	Outreach contacted resident client's medical insurance caseworker to follow up on client's insurance status.
<u>Mental Health</u>	3	Outreach and O.C. Mental Health linked resident client to Adult Protective Services for additional mental health services and general support.
<u>Other</u>	9	Outreach collected donations to distribute to homeless individuals. Such donations included winter items like socks, blankets, backpacks, and jackets.
<u>Rental Resources</u>	2	Outreach linked 2 resident clients to rental assistance programs offered by local housing partners.
<u>Social Services</u>	3	Outreach was contacted by Adult Protective Services and was told that a county social worker will be assigned to resident client to investigate suspected financial abuse.
<u>Substance Abuse</u>	3	Outreach linked resident client to drug treatment facility outside of the City of Costa Mesa, and outreach will follow up with client to check on status.

<u>Transportation</u>	5	Outreach provided 2 bus passes, 2 cab rides to support resident, and 1 gas card to support clients' transportation needs.
