NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Costa Mesa City Council at the regular meeting on **Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 7:00 P.M.**, or soon thereafter, as the matter shall be heard in the City Hall Council Chambers, 77 Fair Drive for:

Description: Conditional Use Permits (CUP) PA-16-26 and PA-16-32 are requests to operate a sober living facility housing up to 22 residents. The applicant also submitted an appeal of the denial of a request for reasonable accommodation to allow this facility relief from various land use requirements. The appeal and the CUPs were denied by the Planning Commission. The applicant has appealed those decisions to the City Council.

Environmental Determination: The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Class 1), Existing Facilities.

Please note that **NO** copies of written communication will be made **AFTER 3:00 p.m.** All materials, pictures, PowerPoints, and videos submitted for display at a public meeting must be previously reviewed by staff to verify appropriateness for general audiences. Kindly submit to the City Clerk **AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE, BUT NO LATER THAN 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THE MEETING**.
