August Weekly Report

CLIENTS CONTACTED, HOUSED AND RECONNECTED

Individuals Assisted	70	50 Resident clients, 15 Non-Resident clients assisted and 5 unknown.
Contacts	76	Outreach made a total of 76 contacts with various clients.
Housing	1	Outreach in collaboration with faith based partner housed resident client to out of city location.
Temporary Housing	6	Outreach in collaboration with housing partners housed 3 non-resident clients on a temporary basis and was informed that 2 resident clients and 1 non-resident client were housed on a temporary basis through an independent source.
Emergency Housing	6	Outreach housed 4 resident clients and 1 non-resident client on an emergency basis and Outreach was informed that non-resident client has been placed in housing on an emergency basis through an independent source.
Reconnection	2	Outreach assisted 2 non-resident clients in reconnecting them to family and out of state housing opportunities.

<u>Collaborative Case Management</u>	30	Outreach provided 30 linkages to collaborative case management services such as housing support services with case manager, medical
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		linkages with hospital social worker, or mental health supportive services with mental health specialist.
<u>Housing Assessments</u>	0	Outreach administered 0 housing assessments on resident client to assess for their eligibility for government subsidized housing.
<u>Documentation</u>	8	Outreach offered resident and non-resident clients with several documentation services such as assisting with completing and sending disabling conditions form, provided identification card vouchers, consent forms, and provided homeless verification form.
<u>Housing/Recovery Assistance</u>	33	Outreach provided resident clients with housing listings for affordable rooms and apartments in their area.
<u>Job Connection</u>	6	Outreach linked 6 resident client to employment resources this week.
<u>Legal Services</u>	3	Outreach linked 3 resident clients to legal services.
<u>Medical</u>	11	Outreach met with non-resident client who was a victim of sexual assault and assisted them in connecting to resources to support their health as they recover from the assault.
<u>Mental Health</u>	11	Outreach and Orange County Outreach and Engagement met with resident client and discussed treatment options and housing opportunities in client's desired out of state location.
<u>Other</u>	11	Outreach educated resident client in how to open a bank account and met client as bank to walk client through the process.
<u>Rental Resources</u>	0	Outreach did not provide any linkages to rental assistance services.
<u>Social Services</u>	4	Outreach assisted resident client in contacting Orange County Social Services to track where client's funds have been dispersed. Outreach was informed client's payee has received funds and will assist client with living expenses.
<u>Substance Abuse</u>	0	Outreach did not provide any linkages to substance treatment services.
<u>Transportation</u>	24	Outreach provided 10 bus passes, ordered 5 cab ride to support resident and provided 9 other services to assist clients' transportation needs.

Total Number of Linkage Hours:	37.70	Outreach collectively spent 37.70 hours providing linkages.
