The Costa Mesa Planning Commission will hold a public hearing at City Hall, 77 Fair Drive, Costa Mesa, California at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, October 22, 2018:

Description: Planning Application 18-37 is a request for a Conditional Use Permit for a marijuana manufacturing and distribution facility (Distillate Company, LLC) within a 6,120-square-foot tenant space of an existing industrial building. The proposed facility will include CO₂ cannabis extraction, winterization, distillation, packaging and distribution of the final product (which includes distillate oil in mason jars to be used for vape cartridges, creams and topicals). Rooms include extraction and distillation, storage and packaging rooms, and ancillary offices. Vehicles used for the distribution of cannabis products will be pulled into a secured area inside the building. The facility will have security systems (card readers, security cameras, etc.) throughout the facility. No cultivation of marijuana, or marijuana dispensary, is permitted.

Environmental Determination: The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Class 1), Existing Facilities.
