**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Costa Mesa Planning Commission will hold a public hearing at the Costa Mesa Senior Center, 695 W. 19<sup>th</sup> Street, Costa Mesa, California at 6:00 p.m. on **Monday, April 8, 2019** to consider the following item:

**Application No.:** RA-19-02 & RA-19-03

**Applicant:** Brandon Stump/The Ohio House

**Site Address:** 2175 Tustin Avenue, Units A and B

**Zone:** R2-MD (Multi-Family Residential, Medium Density)

**Description:** A request for a Reasonable Accommodation to operate a sober living facility housing up to 12 adults in two units. The applicant is requesting relief from certain land use requirements of the Zoning Code. The application for Reasonable Accommodation was denied by the Development Services Director. The applicant has appealed that decision to the Planning Commission.

**Environmental Determination:** The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Class 1), Existing Facilities.
