<u>Collaborative Case Management</u>	31	Bridge shelter: Provided 31 linkages to collaborative case management services such as housing support services with case manager, medical linkages with hospital social worker, or mental health supportive services with mental health specialist.
<u>Housing Assessments</u>	7	Bridge Shelter: Administered 7 housing assessments on shelter guests to assess their eligibility for government-subsidized housing.
<u>Documentation</u>	15	Bridge Shelter: Offered shelter guests several documentation services such as assisting with completing and sending disabling condition forms, provision of identification card vouchers, consent forms, and provided homeless verification forms.

<u>Housing/Recovery Assistance</u>	5	Bridge Shelter: Provided shelter guests with housing listings for affordable rooms and apartments in their area.
<u>Job Connection</u>	3	Bridge Shelter: Linked 3 shelter guests to employment resources.
<u>Legal Services</u>	1	Bridge Shelter: Linked shelter guest to legal services to assist with legal matters.
<u>Medical</u>	20	Bridge Shelter: Referred shelter guest to Public Health Nurse for general medical support services.
<u>Mental Health</u>	13	Bridge Shelter: Linked shelter guest to County Mental Health for mental health evaluation and drug treatment services.
<u>Other</u>	9	Bridge Shelter: Assisted shelter guest in organizing their appointments for the week.
<u>Rental Resources</u>	0	Bridge Shelter: No linkages to rental resources provided this week.
<u>Social Services</u>	16	Bridge Shelter: Linked shelter guest to Veteran Affairs housing case manager to work on getting a veteran housing voucher.
<u>Substance Abuse</u>	0	Bridge Shelter: Did not provide any linkages to substance abuse.
<u>Transportation</u>	24	Bridge Shelter: Provided 13 Bus Passes, 5 Cab Rides, and 6 other transportation services to support shelter guests' transportation needs.
