| Emergency Housing | 0 | Bridge Shelter: Did not provide any linkages to emergency housing this week. |
| Reconnection | 0 | Bridge Shelter: Did not provide any reconnection services this week. |
| Linkage Type | Bridge Shelter | Updates |
| <u>Collaborative Case Management</u> | 36 | Bridge shelter: Provided 36linkages to collaborative case management services such as housing support services with case manager, medical linkages with hospital social worker, or mental health supportive services with mental health specialist. |
| <u>Housing Assessments</u> | 2 | Bridge Shelter: Administered 2 housing assessments on shelter guests to assess their eligibility for government-subsidized housing. |
| <u>Documentation</u> | 29 | Bridge Shelter: Offered shelter guests several documentation services such as assisting with completing and sending disabling condition forms, provision of identification card vouchers, consent forms, and provided homeless verification forms. |

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| <u>Housing/Recovery Assistance</u> | 14 | Bridge Shelter: Provided shelter guests with housing listings for affordable rooms and apartments in their area. |
| <u>Job Connection</u> | 9 | Bridge Shelter: Linked 9 shelter guests to employment resources. |
| <u>Legal Services</u> | 4 | Bridge Shelter: Linked shelter guest to legal services to assist with legal matters. |
| <u>Medical</u> | 18 | Bridge Shelter: In-reach worker assisted shelter guest in making an appointment with medical specialist. In-reach worker will follow up with client and remind them of their upcoming appointment. |
| <u>Mental Health</u> | 12 | Bridge Shelter: In-Reach worker linked shelter guest to licensed clinical social worker for assistance with mental health related services. Such services included clinical professional in administering disability conditions assessment on guest client to determine client's level of disability pertaining to their mental illness. |
| <u>Other</u> | 10 | Bridge Shelter: In-reach assisted shelter guest in linking them to financial support resources on the college campus that shelter guest is attending. These financial support resources will assist shelter guest in completing their educational plan. |
| <u>Rental Resources</u> | 0 | Bridge Shelter: No linkages to rental resources provided this week. |
| <u>Social Services</u> | 17 | Bridge Shelter: In-reach linked shelter guest client to Orange County Social Services to renew public assistance benefits. |
| <u>Substance Abuse</u> | 3 | Bridge Shelter: In-Reach linked shelter guest to interview with drug treatment facility for rehabilitation services. |
| <u>Transportation</u> | 29 | Bridge Shelter: Provided Bus Passes, Cab Rides, and other transportation services to support shelter guests' transportation needs. |
