**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Costa Mesa Zoning Administrator will render a decision on **Thursday, June 20, 2019**, or as soon as possible thereafter, on the following item:

**Description:** Zoning Application 19-24 is a request for a Minor Conditional Use Permit to construct a new small cell facility within the public right-of-way at 2651 Newport Boulevard. The project includes replacement of an existing 28' - 7" Southern California Edison (SCE) street light pole with a new 34' - 9" aggregate pole with antennas and underground equipment in the right-of-way.

**Environmental Determination:** The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15303 (Class 3), New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures.
