<b><u>Collaborative Case Management</u></b>	<b>46</b>	<b>Bridge shelter:</b> Provided 46 linkages to collaborative case management services such as housing support services with case manager, medical linkages with hospital social worker, or mental health supportive services with mental health specialist.
<b><u>Housing Assessments</u></b>	<b>13</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> Administered 13 housing assessments on shelter guests to assess their eligibility for government-subsidized housing.
<b><u>Documentation</u></b>	<b>26</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> Offered shelter guests several documentation services such as assisting with completing and sending disabling condition forms, provision of identification card vouchers, consent forms, and provided homeless verification forms.

<b><u>Housing/Recovery Assistance</u></b>	<b>14</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> Provided shelter guests with housing listings for affordable rooms and apartments in their area.
<b><u>Job Connection</u></b>	<b>1</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> Linked 1 shelter guest to employment resources.
<b><u>Legal Services</u></b>	<b>3</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> Linked shelter guest to legal services to assist with legal matters.
<b><u>Medical</u></b>	<b>22</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> Linked shelter guest to local clinic for a medical checkup.
<b><u>Mental Health</u></b>	<b>11</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> In-reach assisted in linking several shelter guests to county mental health for comprehensive mental health services to address ongoing mental health disorder symptoms.
<b><u>Other</u></b>	<b>6</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> In-reach provided shelter guest with items to support client's physical health.
<b><u>Rental Resources</u></b>	<b>0</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> No linkages to rental resources provided this week.
<b><u>Social Services</u></b>	<b>15</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> In-reach linked shelter guest to resource center located in their city of origin.
<b><u>Substance Abuse</u></b>	<b>3</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> Shelter guest was provided information on various drug treatment facilities available in the area.
<b><u>Transportation</u></b>	<b>36</b>	<b>Bridge Shelter:</b> Provided Bus Passes, Cab Rides, and other transportation services to support shelter guests' transportation needs.
<b>Total Number of Linkages:</b>	<b>196</b>	Bridge Shelter provided 196 linkages this number reflects all underlined linkages.
