Description: Zoning Application 19-39 is a request for a Minor Conditional Use Permit to remodel the existing courtyard space between multiple office buildings to allow for an outdoor activity space. Proposed improvements to the space include a stair structure with stepped seating, a shade canopy, benches and tables, art wall installations, site lighting, and additional paving and landscape.

Environmental Determination: The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Class 1), Existing Facilities.
