<b><u>Housing Assessments</u></b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Street Outreach:</b> Outreach assessed 2 resident client these assessments assess clients' eligibility for government-subsidized housing.

<b><u>Documentation</u></b>	<b>6</b>	<b>Street Outreach:</b> Offered resident and non-resident clients several documentation services such as assisting with completing and sending disabling condition forms, provision of identification card vouchers, consent forms, and provided homeless verification forms.
