

**AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO
TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
WITH
MICHELLE RUDAITIS**

This Amendment Number Two ("Amendment") is effective as of the 30th day of June, 2019 ("Effective Date"), by and between the CITY OF COSTA MESA, a municipal corporation ("City"), and MICHELLE RUDAITIS, an individual ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, City and Consultant entered into an agreement on September 18, 2017 for Consultant to provide hazardous materials consulting services (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of the Agreement provides for a term ending June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2018, City and Consultant amended the Agreement to provide for the option to extend the term of the Agreement for four (4) additional one (1) year periods, extended the term through June 30, 2019, and established Consultant's maximum annual compensation; and

WHEREAS, Consultant has continued to provide the services set forth in the Agreement in a manner satisfactory to City; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant intend and desire to have this Amendment be effective retroactive to the Effective Date; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant now desire to extend the term for one (1) additional year, through June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, City desires to amend Consultant's maximum annual compensation.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. This Amendment shall be effective retroactive to the Effective Date set forth herein.
2. The term of the Agreement shall be extended through June 30, 2020.
3. Section 2.1 of the Agreement shall be amended to reflect that Consultant's annual compensation shall not exceed Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00). City shall pay Consultant an hourly rate of Ninety-Five Dollars (\$95.00) for all services performed by Consultant.
4. All terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning and use as set forth in the Agreement.
5. All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement not in conflict with this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.


